2. End of Third term 2024 & Reporting back for first term 2025

Third term for non-candidate students has ended today **Friday 29th and Saturday 30th November 2024 for both girls and boys respectively**. While candidates of both secular and theology have gradually been departing upon completing their final examinations except a few senior six's who are still writing theirs up to **Friday, 6th December 2024**

The school management organized the Thalitha Thanawi graduation (Haflah) which was fabulous. We appreciate parents for their attendance and support which made the occasion colorful


